


Theater

Discover the world of Theater with lesson plans, videos, interactive activities, and more. High school students will get an inside look at the life of a theater actor as they complete a four-square graphic organizer and watch a video in the lesson plan, "John Leguizamo's Tales From a Ghetto Klown - An Actor's Life." Younger students will explore what it means to be a playwright and come to know the different aspects of a script through the interactive, "Job Play: Playwright." Many theater classics, such as August Wilson's *The Piano Lesson*, Shakespeare's *Otello*, and Lorraine Hansberry's *A Raisin in the Sun*, are presented with lesson plans and teacher and student support materials. Theater styles, the history of theater, and theater in world cultures are a few of the additional topics explored in Theater.
