
ELA Writing



ELA Writing explores all types of writing, including argumentative, personal, and explanatory narrative and writing. Students are encouraged to examine their implicit biases in an interactive lesson titled, "Who, Me? Biased?", and storytelling elements are investigated as students are encouraged to use pictures to expand their writing. In a series of workshops, middle school teachers can learn a variety of best practices for teaching students the steps of writing different types of text, such as poetry and multigenre. Writing research projects, using textual evidence, and publishing technology are also included in the ELA Writing resources.
