Middle and high school students can preview and build competing arguments for and against government-funded healthcare using a series of videos titled, "Life. Support. Music." A lesson plan called "The Lowdown" explores the causes and consequences of the opioid epidemic, including a chance to view the epidemic through the eyes of fellow teens. Emergency procedures, insuring pre-existing conditions, and medical ethics are also explored in Consumer Health.
